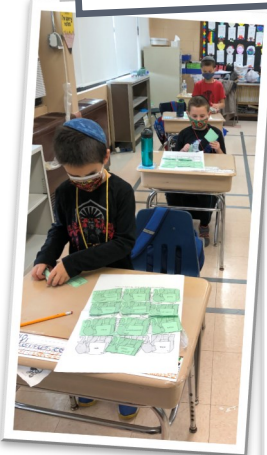


## 1st Grade News

## Stay & Play experiments with the season of Fall!

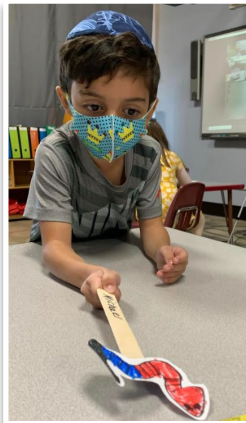

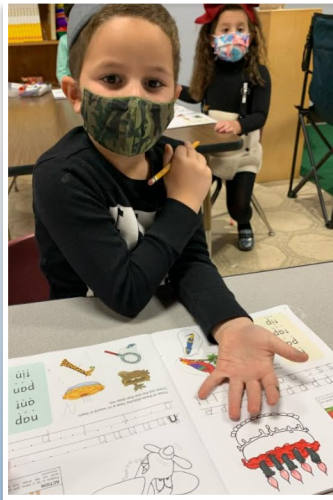


## All About Kindergarten!

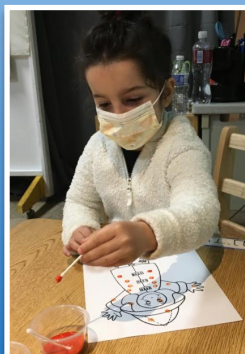
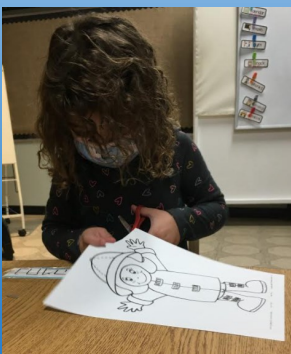
We are learning about measuring using the "inchworm" method.
