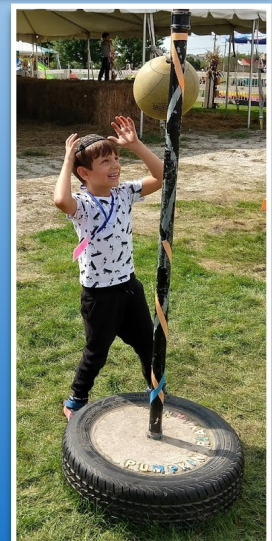

Skills Practiced: Creating squares and rectangles with lines, coloring inside shapes



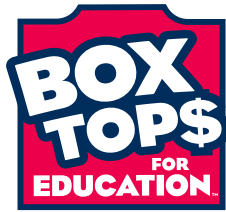

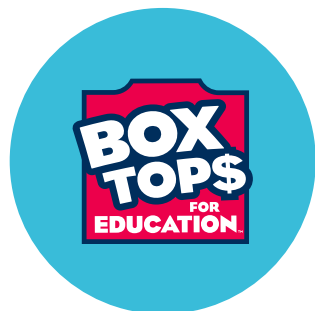

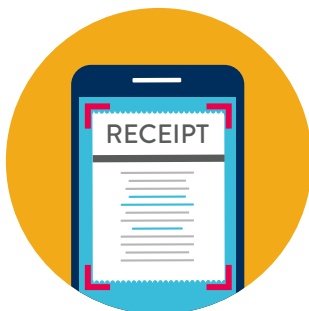
