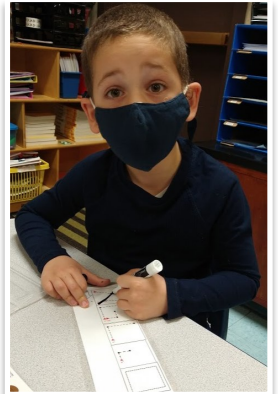
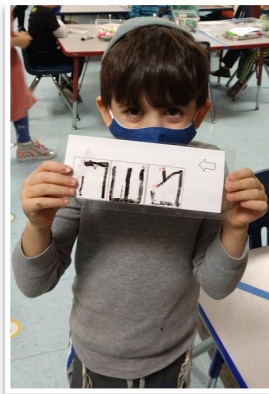
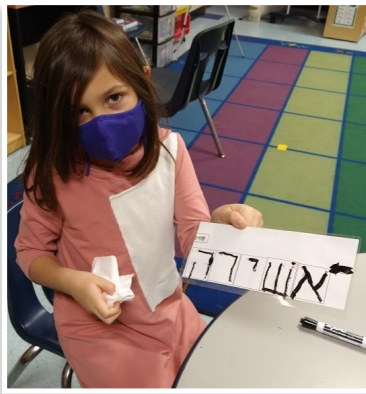
Pre-Nursery Explores Parshas Lech Lecha

The Kindergarten yeladim can form the Alef Beis letters using all kinds of things! They especially love to practice writing their special Jewish names on personalized dry erase cards.



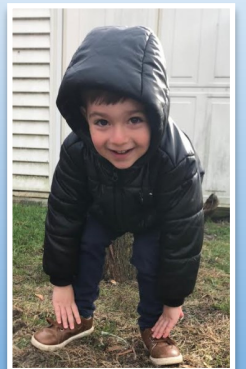
