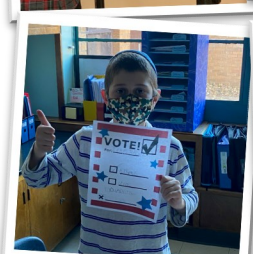
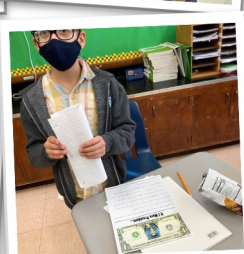
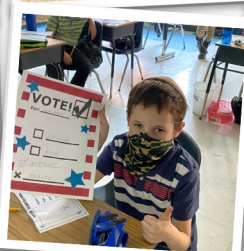
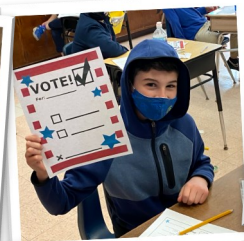
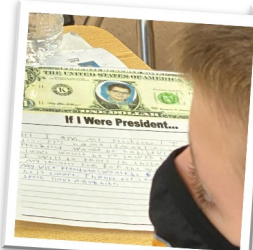
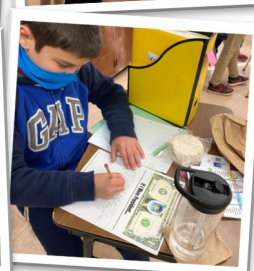
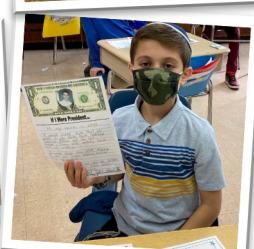
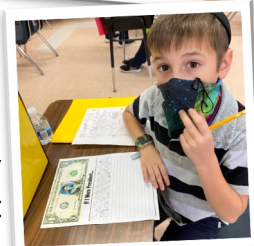
4th Grade News

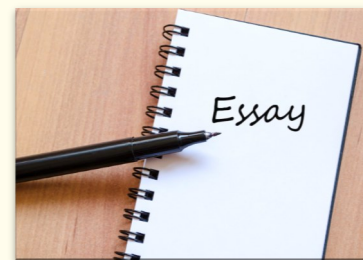

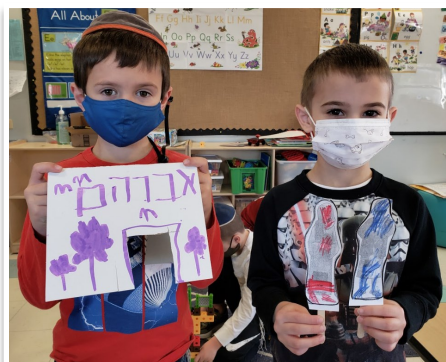

We learn from Avraham the mitzvah of *Hachnasas Orchim!*

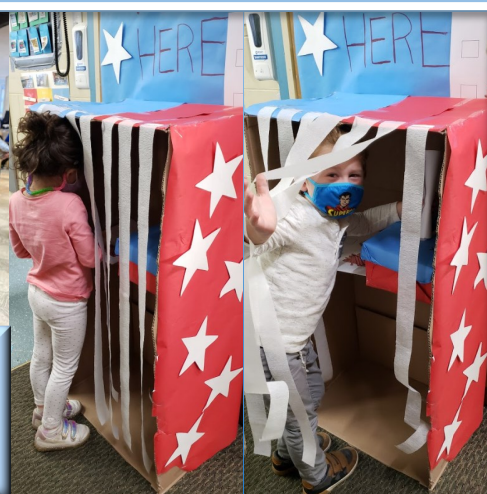
The Kindergarten yeladim made Avraham's tent with 4 doors and puppets to act out the parsha story of Avraham and the malachim.

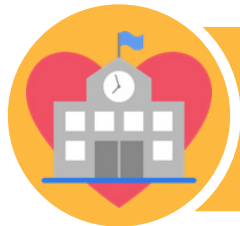

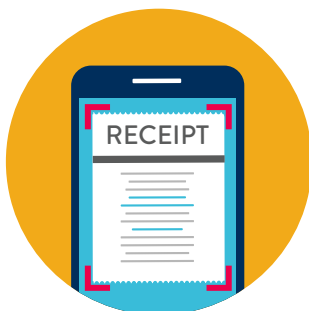
