




MIDDOS MATTER CORNER

Pre-Nursery and Nursery enjoy the Animal Yoga classes given by our own Morah Michelle and Morah Batyah!
















The Kindergarten classes at Arie Crown explored the difference between light and dark for the Parsha of Bereishis. They learned all about the electron and how it glows when it gets excited, often through a chemical reaction. We learned that the sun gives off UV light that we cannot see, but with the help of a special filtered flashlight, we were able to see it. We used the UV flashlights to explore glowing objects as well as ourselves. This is the essence of our parsha science program, *Vayehi Ohr*, enlightening our students' minds to Torah through science!
