



The Kindergarten Yeladim are already up to the letter "Heh!" Look at some of the types of medium the Yeladim use to learn the letters and sounds of the Alef Beis!













The Kindergarten Yeladim made a two-sided doll for Parshas Toldos. One side was red and hairy for Eisav and one side was smooth and dressed in Shabbos clothes for Yaakov. We used our 5 senses this week to help us understand why Eisav, when **smelling** delicious soup, may have wanted to trade the "Bechora" for food. We **tasted** red soup and yes, it sure was delicious! The Yeladim did agree, B"H, that they still would NOT make the same trade as Eisav and Yaakov! The sensory box helped us understand how someone who is blind uses their other senses to know what is happening around them.





Getting ready for Chanukah in Kindergarten! The Yeladim used their math skills to count how many candles we light on each night of Chanukah! In Kindergarten this week, we were busy learning and writing numbers 1-5, & the letters "E" & "H". We spent a lot of time outside, enjoying the crisp, sunny fall weather. We also had a blast with freeze dance!





























In honor of Parshas Toldos, the Pre Nursery Yeladim made salt dough and shaped it into bowls. When the dough was dry, the Yeladim painted their bowls and glued red lentils in them to create lentil soup, just like Yaakov cooked in this week's Parsha. The Yeladim also learned that Yitzchak was blind, so he used his sense of touch to feel Yaakov. We further explored our sense of touch by gluing different textured collage materials onto a tongue depressor to create a texture stick. Furthermore, in conjunction with Parshas Toldos, we have been learning about opposites and the same & different. The Yeladim had a blast participating in opposite yoga and completing opposite puzzles.













This week in Nursery Stay and Play, we learned about Fall. We took advantage of the beautiful weather and went on a Fall Scavenger Hunt around the different playgrounds at school. We looked for a blade of grass, a flower, different color leaves etc. We really had fun exploring! We then became little scientists and learned why leaves change colors and what chlorophyll is. For our experiment we collected brown, red, yellow and green leaves. We then ripped them up into small pieces, put them in a mason jar, covered them with rubbing alcohol and then cut a coffee filter. We watched all week and saw the colors travel up the filter and reveal the leaves' true colors! And finally in art we made beautiful leaf print paintings.


