Reminder! Please send an extra mask in your child(ren)'s backpack. Sometimes they get dirty or break in the middle of the school day. Thank you!

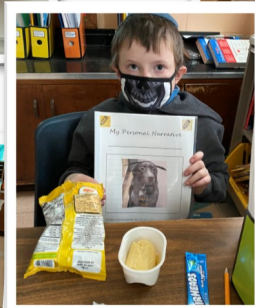
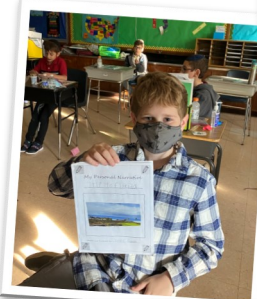
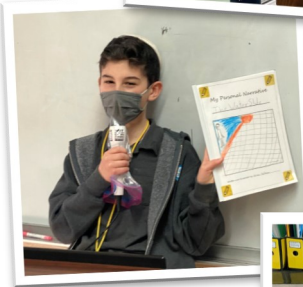
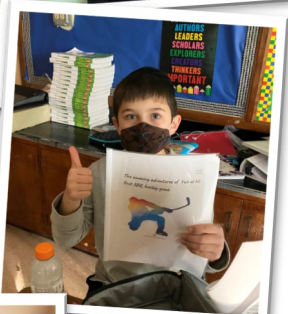
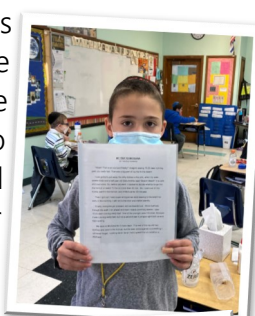
