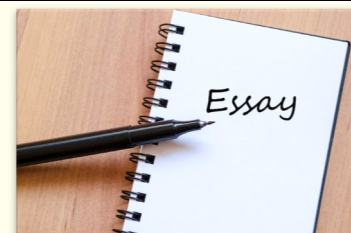

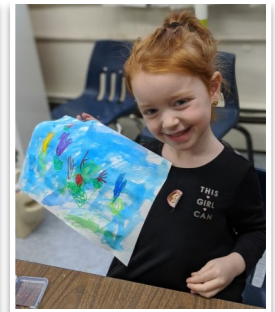

Welcome to our Spring Hot Lunch Sign-Up!

Hot lunch will be served 3 days a week: Monday, Wednesday and Thursday. ACHDS student council will be offering their Tel Aviv pizza lunch fundraiser every Tuesday as well. This is the single sign-up for both programs, and the final sign-up this school year.

Food from this year's hot lunch program is provided by Starr Kosher Catering. Each meal costs \$4.35 and includes a small, 8 oz. water bottle. Each day, except Monday, has two alternating menus. Please note that sign up is by the day and choosing the day means your child will receive both menu items. For example, if you sign up your child for the Wednesday lunch option, your child will receive lunch on days when hot dogs are served and on days when pasta with meat sauce is served.

**The deadline for sign up is Sunday, January 12<sup>th</sup> at MIDNIGHT.** No orders will be accepted after that time. This sign up is for lunches served from **January 27, 2020 through June 9, 2020**, and is the only time to sign up. Please make every effort to choose the correct grade for each student and double check your order before submitting to ensure that your child receives lunch. **PLEASE NOTE: YOU WILL BE REQUIRED TO ENTER YOUR FAMILY ID # (LISTED IN THE EMAIL). IF YOU DO NOT ENTER THE CORRECT NUMBER, YOUR PAYMENT WILL NOT BE APPLIED PROPERLY TO YOUR ACCOUNT.**

- If you do not receive a confirmation email, your order did NOT go through.

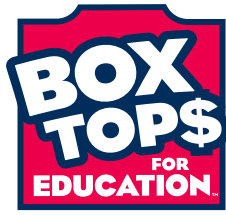

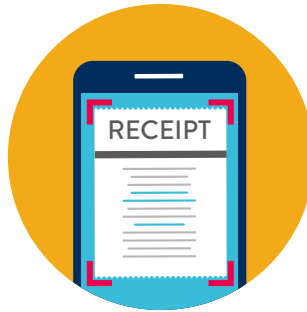

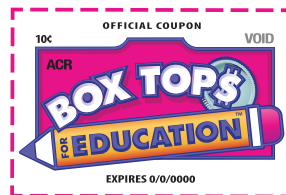
