3rd Grade News

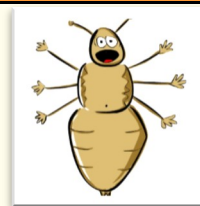

KINDERGARTEN



The Pre-Nursery Yeladim were so excited to come back to school after winter break! We may have been stuck inside because of the frigid weather, but we made the most of it! We made yummy hot soup for snack, danced to Morah Music, and we played ball, climbed, and ran in the Gross Motor Room! For our Parsha project this week

we collaged special signs for our kitchens to mark the milchig and fleishig areas. And we finished our color unit with the color purple/segol—and a super fun color hunt in Hebrew with all the colors we learned!



The Yeladim in Kindergarten had a visit from SWANCC Waste Reduction to learn all about recycling this week. They learned the three "r's" that will help preserve the Earth: reduce, reuse and recycle. They learned which things are garbage, which things can be reused, and what can be recycled.



The Kindergarten learned about kosher food from this week's parsha. They learned what foods are חלבי (dairy), what foods are בשרי (meat) and what is pareve. They are kosher experts!

The Kindergarten know all of the בגדי חורף (winter clothes). They are all ready for the cold weather!





The Kindergarten children learned the letter 'W' by having a **Wacky Wednesday** celebration on....you guessed it....**Wednesday**! The children looked adorable and **wacky** and had a **wonderful** time with activities such as **Whack the Word** and the **Wishy Washer Washerwoman** movement activity. The children loved finding all the silly things that **were wrong** in the Dr. Seuss book **Wacky Wednesday**. We also tried substituting the first letter of each of our names with a **W**! Try it and see how **wacky** you sound!



In honor of Dr. Martin Luther King Jr's birthday, the Kindergarten children studied about Dr. King and Rosa Parks, two people who dedicated their lives to spreading the message of treating everyone fairly, equally, and with respect. We learned that all people are the same inside, regardless of what they look like. We did a terrific, hands-on demonstration to illustrate this point, using brown and white eggs. First we noted the similarities and differences between the two eggs (mostly similarities). Then each child was given either a brown or a white egg to crack to see if they look different inside. They noticed that all the eggs looked the same inside, regardless of the color of the shell. This really helped them understand that all of us are the same inside and that people should all be treated equally and get along. (And we discovered some very good egg-crackers in the class!)



This week in Stay & Play the Pre-Nursery classes did our first author unit! We loved reading about Pete the Cat and doing activities based on the books. We even created our very own Pete using blue construction paper! We enjoyed decorating shoes like Pete's special shoes, doing "cat poses," and even eating some of the foods that Pete stepped into while walking along and singing his song. Best of all, we learned from Pete that when things don't go our way we can choose to look at them in a whole new way rather than get upset!

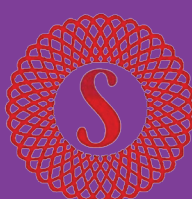


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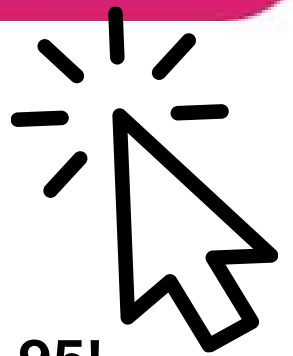
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
