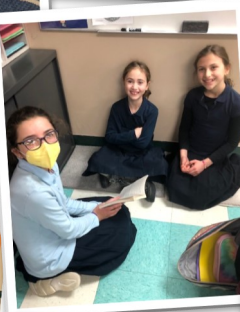

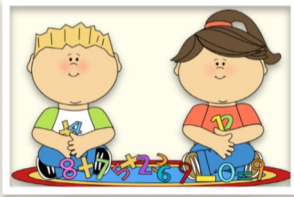
Picture Retake Day

3. Please do not wear green!
4. Girls in grades 1-7 who are retaking pictures do not need to wear a uniform shirt. However, a uniform skirt must be worn.
5. 8th Grade girls who are retaking pictures and would like to wear a dress for pictures should change into school uniform after the picture (there will not be full pose pictures).

The Pre Nursery Yeladim have been learning about Shabbos and working hard on creating their very own Shabbos Play Sets. The Yeladim put their fine motor and artistic skills to work as they colored in a Shabbos themed stencil to decorate a candle tray, stuck gems on a cup to beautify it for Kiddush, stuffed and braided stockings to make challah, put cloves in esrogim to create pomander for besamim, and melted and twisted two Chanukah candles together in order to give the candle two wicks for havdalah. We had so much fun playing "What's Missing" with our classroom's Shabbos Play Set while we worked on creating our own. In a fun science, math, and baking activity, we made challah from scratch. During the challah baking we did an experiment and were amazed to see that when yeast and warm water are placed in a bottle with a balloon on top, the yeast causes the balloon to blow up. In honor of Shabbos, we enjoyed a special Shabbos sing along with AY Karsh. Of course, we also made time for all of the other fun things we do in Pre Nursery such as gym, music, gross motor room, sensory room, Parsha (each yeled made a beautiful choshen using bleeding tissue paper last week for Parshas Tetzaveh), and lots of smiles!

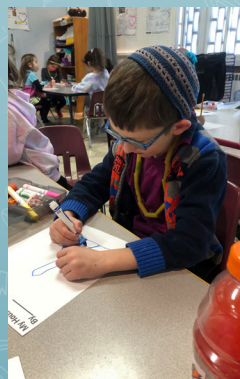
