## Let's Get Cooking!

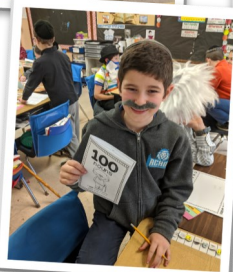
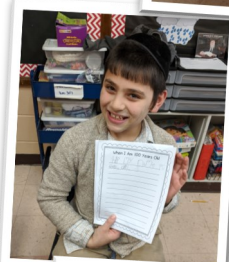
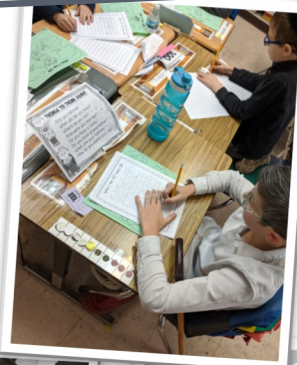
