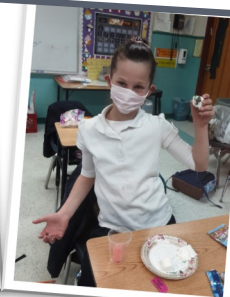
Mrs. Biala's amazing 4th grade completed Parshas Vaeira!

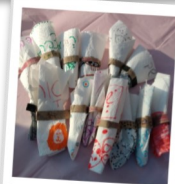
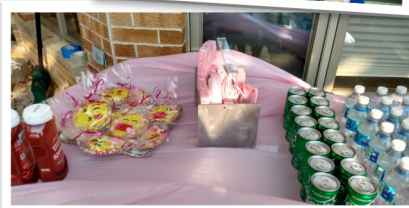

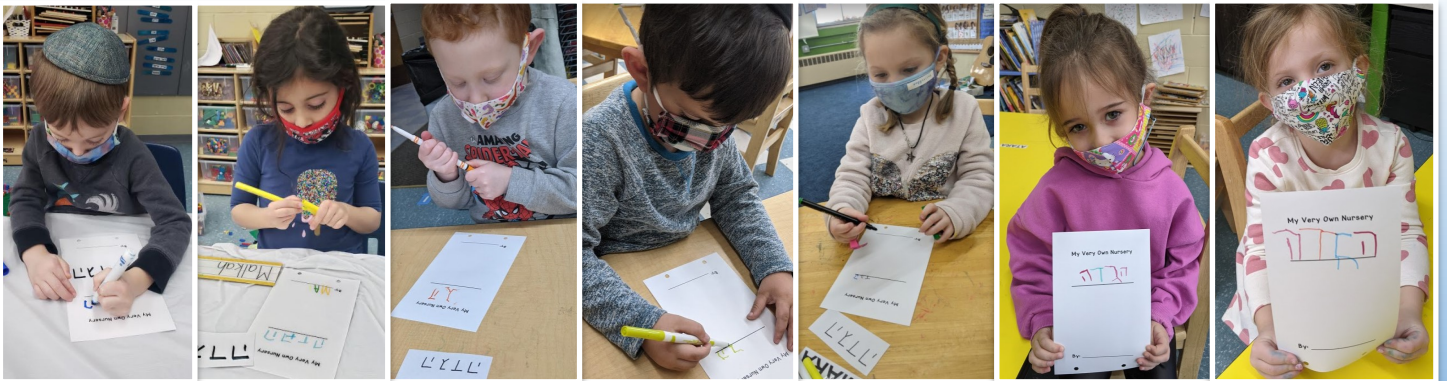


Pre-Nursery Prepares for Pesach!

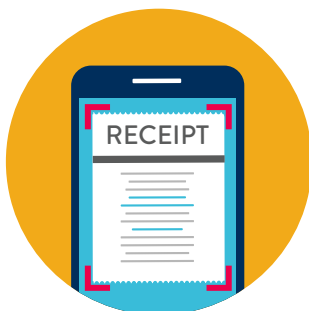
