

Lunch With a Legend News

Rebbetzin Chaya Small was our speaker for our Rosh Chodesh Adar "Lunch with a Legend". Rebbetzin Small, the daughter of Rabbi Shmuel David and Rebbetzin Tzivia Walkin, was imbued with a keen sense of responsibility, chesed and love towards her fellow Jews and community. As a young girl, she remembers her terrifying escape from Poland to Vilna—the miraculous

transit visa in Kovno, issued by the famous Japanese counsel Chiune Sugihara. They fled, along with the Mirrer Yeshiva to Vladistok and ultimately to Kobe, Japan and then Shanghai, China.

Recollecting is a religious duty and Rebbetzin Small described to us the terror she experienced as a 6 year old child escaping the Nazis שמם. At the very same time the Rebbetzin stressed to us the miracles that Hashem did for her

family and the Mirrer Yeshiva. She taught us about the power of one, of chesed, and dedication to the continuation of learning Torah and building Torah institutions in strong Jewish communities. Rebbetzin Small stressed to both the 8th grade boys and girls that they are the continuation of Yiddishkite and glorious

Torah tradition. We each have a very special potential. She conveyed a positive and inspiring message to continue to build strong Jewish homes and Yeshivos.

We are so grateful to Rebbbetzin Small for coming to Arie Crown and sharing some of her life story enhanced by an educational power point.


5th Grade News




