This past Monday, the second grade boys were introduced to different types of clay and pottery tools by Mrs. Rubin of Claynguage.

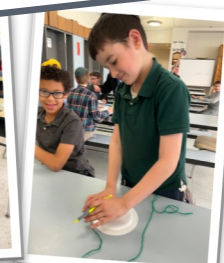
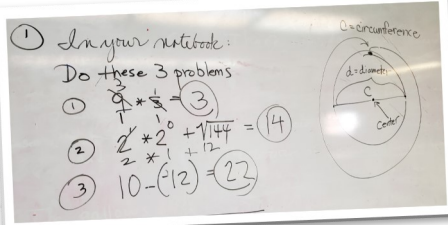

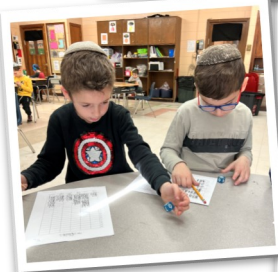
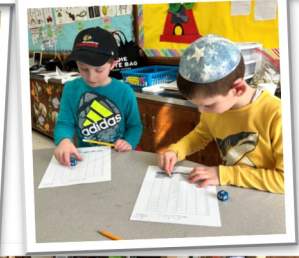
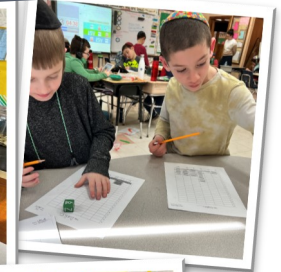
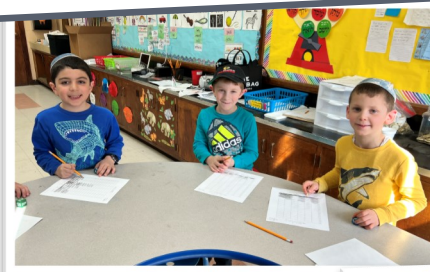
6th and 8th Grade News

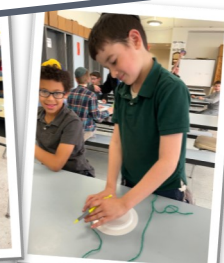
