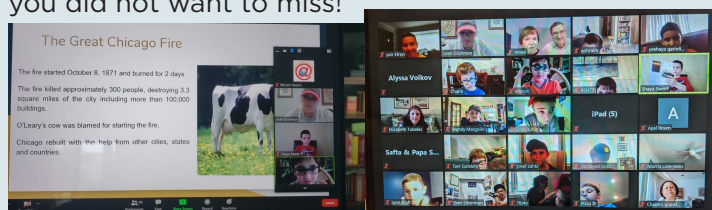

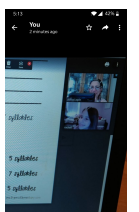

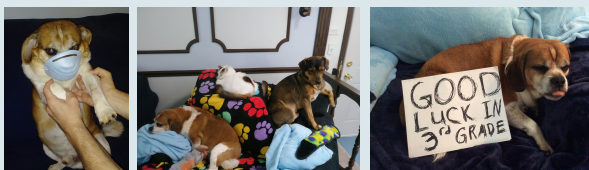
## 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade News
