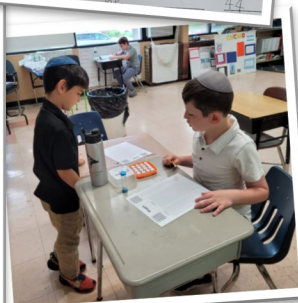
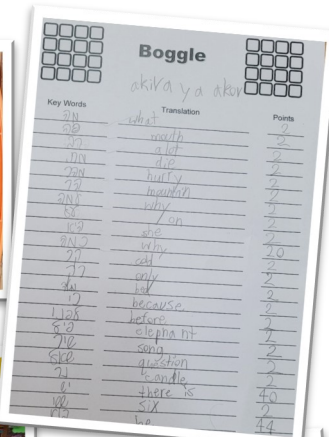

### Big Sister-Little Sister Program

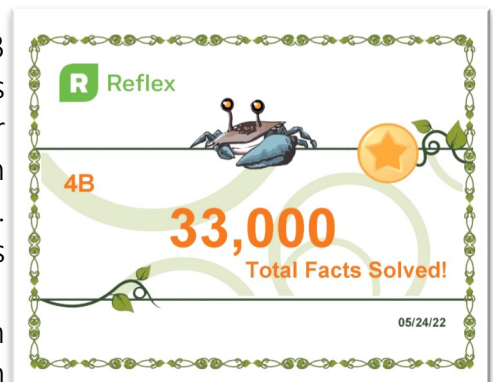
