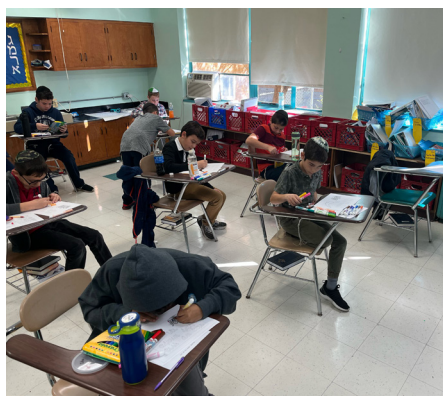

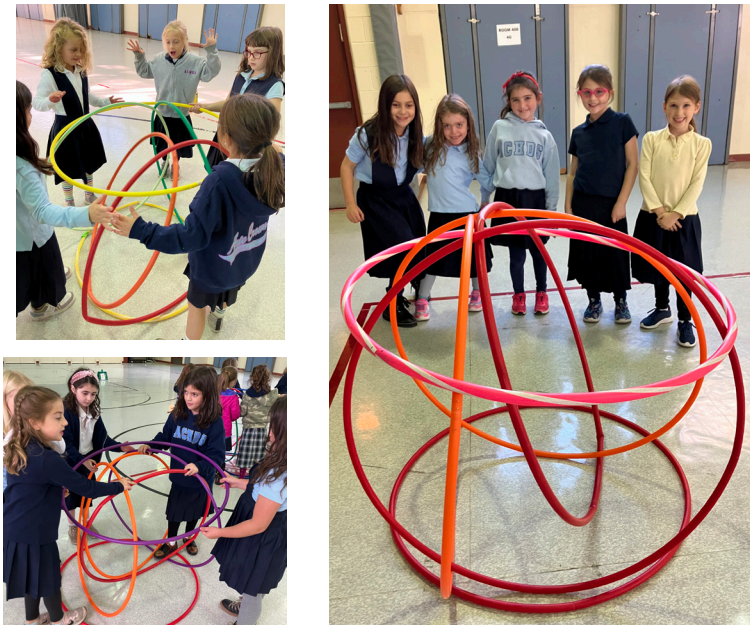
6th Grade Girls News

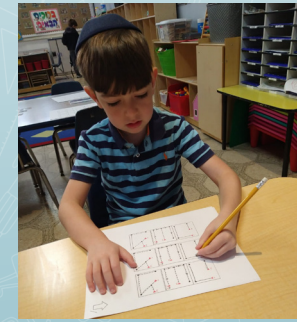
Noach built a Tavah and so did the Emerald Room!

Parshas Noach came alive this week as we played out the story of the animals going on the Tavah, we painted the water of the Mabul and we built the Tavah out of a variety of materials. Even the animals that went on the Tavah came to visit us at Early Childhood!



This week in Nursery Stay and Play we explored fall! Everyone enjoyed being scientists and doing a leaf experiment. We crushed up red, yellow, green, and brown leaves and covered them with rubbing alcohol. We then added a coffee filter on top and watched all week long as the color in each jar traveled up the filter! This taught us a lot about Photosynthesis! We know that leaves need sunlight, water, and air to live and in the fall they don't get a lot of sunlight which makes the leaves lose their green color.





The colors of the rainbow were a Kindergarten theme this week, as we welcomed Chodesh Cheshvan and as they learned about Parshas Noach. We experimented with 'walking waters' to make all of the colors of the rainbow out of the three primary ones! We learned about why we need rain. The Kindergartners are learning to properly form their Hebrew names!



K1 was so excited to come back from break! We learned the letters C, K and E and had fun in the gross motor room!

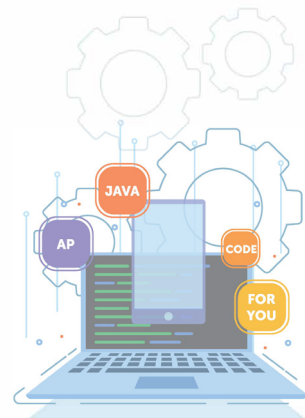

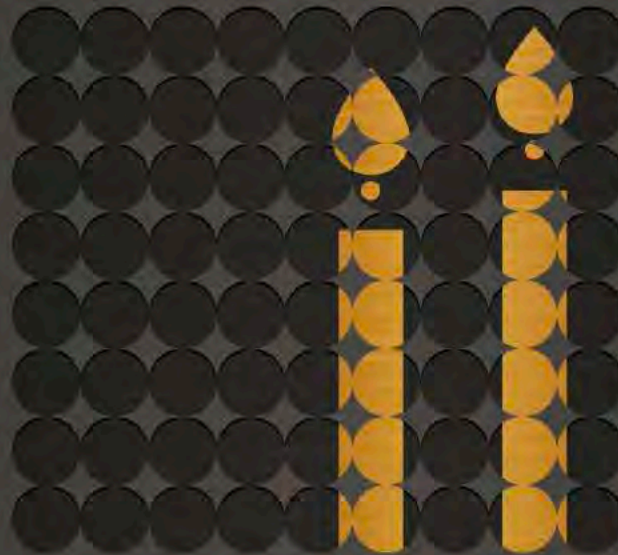
