100th Day of School

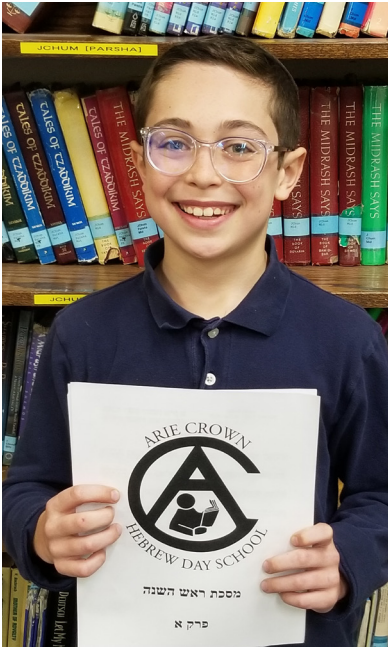
On Wednesday, February 22nd the 1st-3rd graders celebrated the 100th day of school. Each class did their own fun educational activities in the theme of "100".

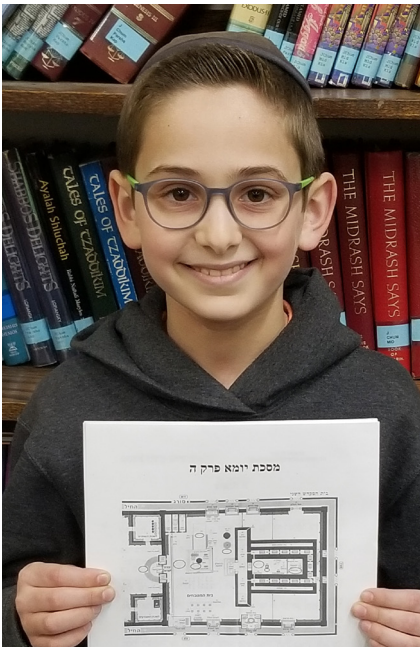
Boys Mishmar Spotlight
