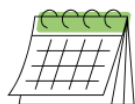

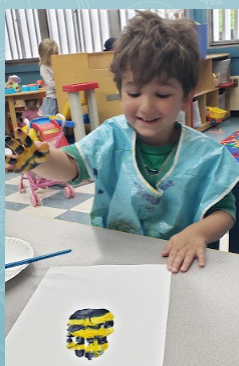
Pre-Nursery splatter
