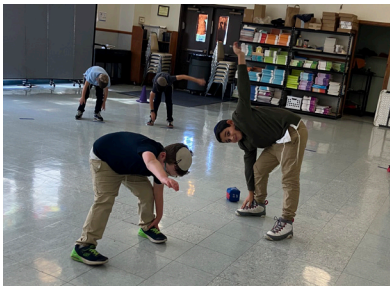
Art News

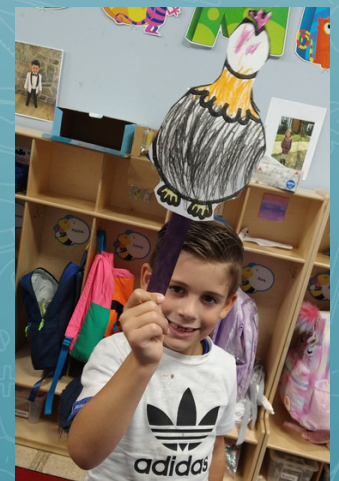
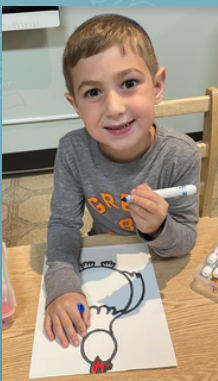
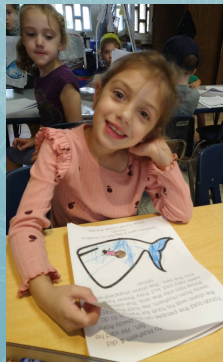
