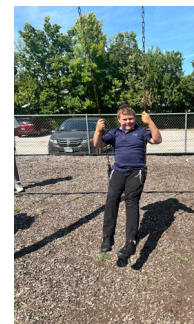


5TH GRADE BOYS news

PARENT/VISITOR *policy*

For the safety of all of our children, all parents and visitors must enter the school through the Main Street entrance. Please do not attempt to enter at another entrance or ask a child or staff member to open or hold open another entrance for you. During drop-off (8:15- 8:30) the entrance to the girls' elementary wing, located by the Kenton parking lot, will also be open for parents to walk their children to their classrooms during the first week of school.

When entering the main entrance, all visitors will be greeted at our security window by a staff person and required to submit a valid ID in exchange for a Visitor's Pass. This visitor necklace must be worn around the neck during the entire visit. Upon leaving the building, the ID will be returned to the visitor when the Visitor's Pass is turned in. This step will enable us to track who is in our building at all times in order to ensure the safety of both our children and our visitors. We thank all of the parents for being cooperative in this policy.

BUS/CARPOOL *notice*

Our administration has once again been working diligently with the Skokie Police Department to ensure the safest dismissal procedures possible for this school year. It is imperative that you read the procedures and review them with your child(ren) so you both are aware of where you need to be during morning arrival and afternoon dismissal.

MORNING ARRIVAL LOCATIONS

Morning arrival at the main campus is from 8:15 a.m.- 8:30 a.m. Classes begin promptly at 8:30 a.m. There is no early morning drop off. Please only drop off at the location assigned to you.

*If you are assigned to drop off on Main Street, please drive West on Main street and pull up as far as possible toward the field, following the instructions of the traffic and safety volunteers and staff members. Girls in grades 4-8 should enter the building through the door that leads straight upstairs to the 400 wing. All other students should enter through the side door near the field that leads to the 300 wing.

*If you are assigned to drop off on Kenton, please drive West on Main street and turn right onto Kilpatrick. Follow the street around on Elm Terrace

and pull up as far as possible on Kenton toward Main, following the instructions of the traffic and safety volunteers and staff members. Do not block any driveways on Elm Terrace or Kenton. All students should enter through the side door on Kenton.

IMPORTANT SAFETY ITEMS TO NOTE:

*For the safety of the students, staff and other drivers, please note that it is illegal to be on your cell phone during carpool.

*Students should only exit your vehicle on the school side and never the street side.

*Please watch out for bike riders and avoid blocking the bike lane.

MINYAN ARRIVAL

Minyan arrival at the main campus for boys in Grades 6-8 is from 7:15am - 7:30 am in the Kilpatrick lot that is located next to the large field. Students should enter through the door marked "8" which leads straight to the gym. Please note that this door will only be manned and open until 8:00am.

BUSING STUDENTS

The morning minyan bus route begins at 6:40am. For the first week, we recommend that your children wait outside a few minutes early. As the week progresses, you will be able to determine the approximate daily pick up time for your child's stop.

Main Campus Afternoon Busing

At 3:55 pm, ALL students who will be taking the bus will be dismissed to Main Street. Buses are scheduled to depart from school at 4:05 pm daily and at 1:20 pm on short Fridays.

Bus routes have been completed. Numerous hours of work were spent organizing the most efficient routes. Please be patient and allow the next several weeks for the bus drivers to learn the nuances of these routes. No changes will be made in the routes for at least the next 4 weeks.

As a reminder, for the safety of all students, it is the expectation of the school that any students in grades K-4 who are not being walked home by a sibling or neighbor should be met at their afternoon bus stop by an adult.

The school will contact parents via text message if a bus does not leave the school by 4:10 PM.

*Only students who are signed up for busing are allowed to ride the bus.

*Students must only ride on the bus to which they

are assigned. Bus students may not ride a different bus, even if it is just for one day, without the express permission of the front office. Please do not instruct your child to ride a different bus unless you have already emailed the office and received approval for the switch.

***No bus switches will be made after 2:30 pm.**

***No bus switches will be allowed for the first two weeks of school.**

*If a family is moving and a bus change is needed, please email emashiach@ariecrown.org at least 2 weeks before the move.

CARPOOL STUDENTS

Please share this information with anyone who is driving (i.e. grandparents etc.)

Each carpool family should have received two copies of a colored, laminated carpool number at Back to School Days. If you did not, please stop by the business office to pick them up. You must display your school issued number near the passenger side of your front windshield when doing carpool.

Lincolnwood, Peterson Park, Skokie, and Northern Suburbs Carpools:

*Students will be dismissed to the Kilpatrick parking lot at 3:55 pm (1:10 pm on short Fridays).

*Parents should park in the Kilpatrick lot where your children will come to meet you.

*Please enter the Kilpatrick lot off of Main St. onto Kilpatrick only. All carpools must exit right out of the Kilpatrick lot to Elm Terrace.

*For everyone's safety, if you arrive after 3:55 pm (1:10 pm on short Fridays), do not back into your parking spot.

*Do not lead your children through the middle of the parking lot to get to your car, rather walk on the outer sidewalks of the parking lot until you arrive at your car.

*Do not park in any ACCESSIBLE DESIGNATED SPOT unless you have the legal placard permit to do so.

West Rogers Park Carpools:

*All West Rogers Park students will go to the Beis Medrash when dismissed at 3:55 pm.

*Students will be called out to Kenton Ave. when their carpool arrives and is in the proper loading area.

*To enter the carpool line please turn onto Kilpatrick off of Main St. only. You should then circle around Elm Terrace to Kenton Ave where the carpool line will form.

*Please adhere to the ACHDS staff and Skokie Police directions when you arrive in order to ensure the

safety of the students.

***Carpool drivers MUST remain in their cars.** If you feel that you must get out of your car to load your child/ carpool please park in a permitted spot on the east side of Kenton or south side of Main and walk your carpool to your car. Drivers getting out of their cars in the active carpool lane causes safety concerns and impedes running a smooth carpool line.

*Please stay alert so you can move forward promptly when the space in front of you opens up. Stay off your phones. It is illegal and extremely dangerous.

*Do not stop for any reason in the middle of the street to try to load your carpool.

ALL FAMILIES

Please note that we will continue to strictly enforce the no parking area on Main St. and Kenton Ave. beginning at 3:30 pm each day (12:45 pm on short Fridays).

If you have to pick up your child over the course of the school day, please find appropriate street parking and come into the building and check your child out from the office.

LOST & FOUND *news*

Please remember to label all items that go to school.

Some tips:

- All types of shoes end up in the Lost and Found each year - either due to changing out of boots, or into gym shoes. Consider labeling shoes as well.

- There are thin rectangle labels that are perfect for labeling eyeglasses. Labeling eyeglasses enables us to return them to their rightful owner when they show up in the Lost and Found.

- When school sweatshirts are distributed, remember to label immediately, as these are one of the most commonly found items in the Lost and Found. There are very handy name stampers available that are great for labeling clothing.

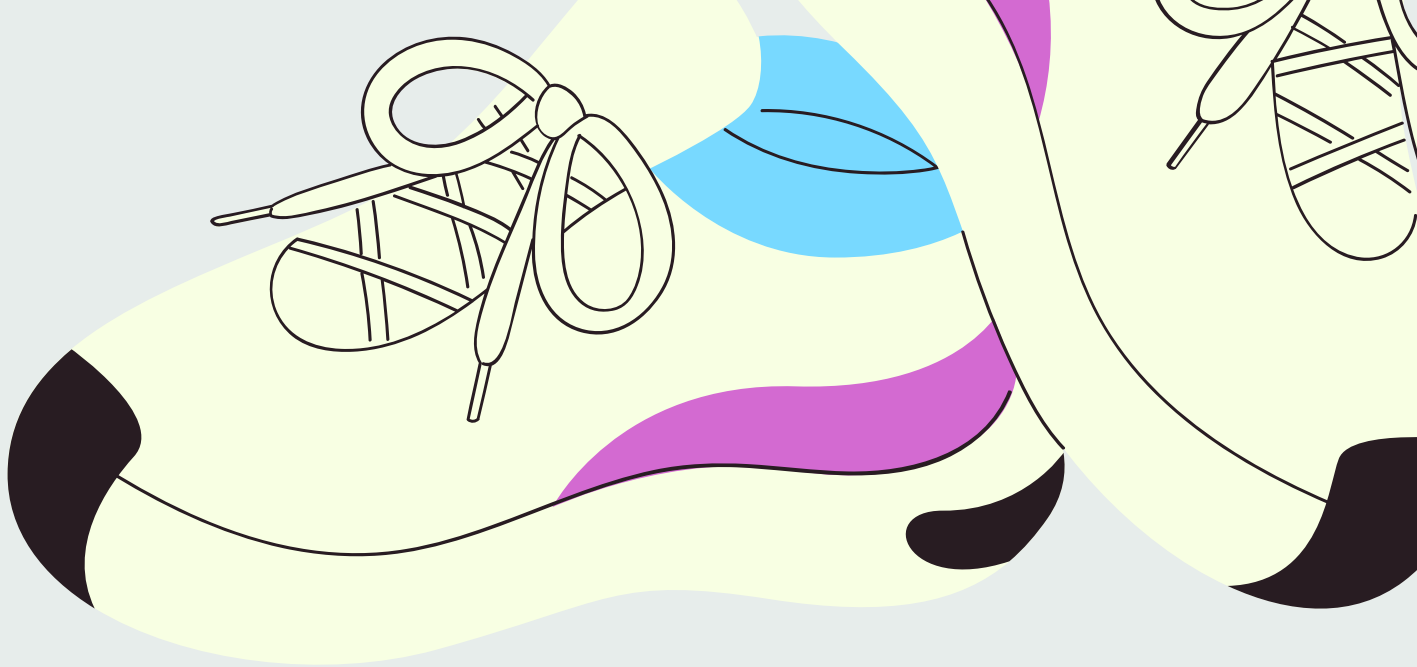

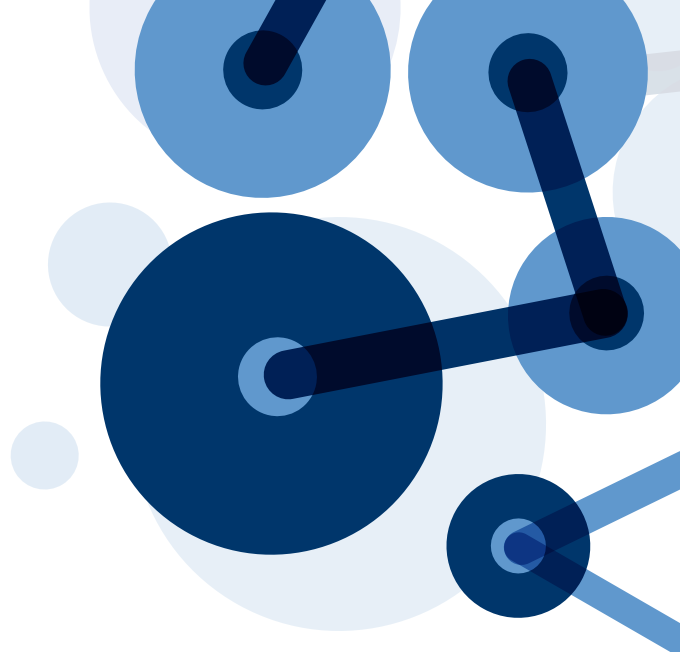

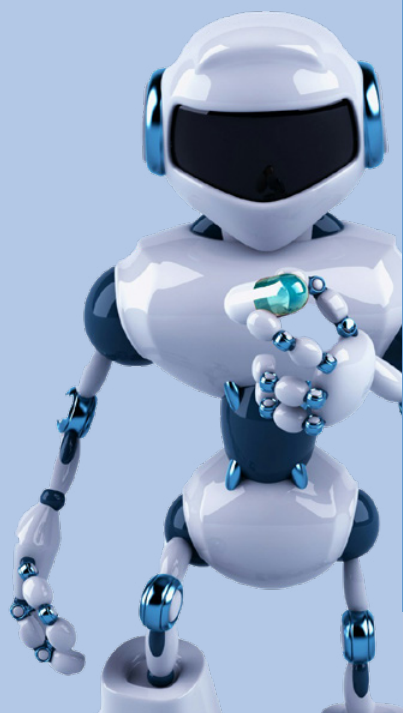
