Esrog Exploration in the Plum Room Pre-Nursery

Before Sukkos we taught the Yeladim that they had to be very careful when touching the Esrog. Now that Sukkos is over we are enjoying an Esrog Exploration Unit! We were thrilled to be able to touch and smell the Esrogim and to see what they look like inside! We compared the Esrog seeds to apple seeds and pomegranate seeds. We even planted some Esrog seeds to see if they'll grow. The Yeladim noticed that the bigger Esrog from Italy smelled very different than the smaller Esrog from Morocco. Morah brought in some older, dried Esrogim and the Yeladim are making observations each day to see how long it will take for the new Esrogim to dry out. We predict they will be dry by Chanukah.

It was a busy week in Kindergarten this week. The Kindergarten Yeladim made snow globes for Parshas Lech Lecha to show how impossible it is to count the stars in the sky! They were also introduced to the Patach, the first nekuda!!



Kindergarten students celebrated the arrival of the Fall season with a fun and educational trip to the Grove Nature Center! The weather was perfect and we had a wonderful time on our nature walk, spotting an owl and a black squirrel hiding in a tree. We experienced life as early pioneers in a cabin, practicing chores such as ironing, sewing, grinding corn, and drawing water from the well. Seeing a giant stuffed bear was really cool! In the exploration center the children learned many interesting facts about snakes and were even allowed to pet one. It felt much smoother and softer than we all expected. Our Kindergarten students made a tremendous Kiddush Hashem with their beautiful Middos and behavior, impressing everyone at the Grove! We are so proud of them and we hope we get to go on another trip soon!



This week the Nursery Stay And Play learned all about TEETH.

We learned that typically we have 20 baby teeth (primary) and 32 adult teeth (permanent). We also discussed why we have teeth and how to take care of them. We did a cool Science experiment using eggs (teeth) and poured vinegar in one cup and coke in another and then placed eggs inside each. We observed the eggs and noticed how the shell became soft showing how coke and acid destroy the enamel of the teeth . We brushed marbles and pictures of teeth! We made gums with teeth out of salt water dough and beans! We played with mint scented shaving cream, Play dough and floss! However, the most enjoyed activity was making mouths out of apple slices and placing marshmallows on the apples for teeth. What a blast!!!
