In Kindergarten literacy we learned the vowel team of 'ee' and the general rule that 'when 2 vowels go walking, the first one does the talking'. We added an important word to our vocabulary- perseverance- as we read an adorable book called Sneezy the Snowman, about a snowman that kept melting and getting rebuilt. We composed a class book illustrating things we are not yet able to do but we will keep on trying until we succeed! In Science, the students learned about different types of trees and were surprised to discover that there is even a blue tree! We learned that the bark protects the tree from insects and predators. The weather was beautiful so we went outside to make observations about the different trees in the playground. Using magnifying glasses, the students noted the many textures, colors, directions of markings, patterns, and ridges. They made bark rubbings to compare the different markings and concluded that we have oak and pine trees in our playground. Back inside the classroom, the students continued their observations and compiled a list of the various textures they felt. What a 'tree-mendous' Science lesson!
