The 3rd and 4th grade boys enjoyed math activities in honor of Pi Day!



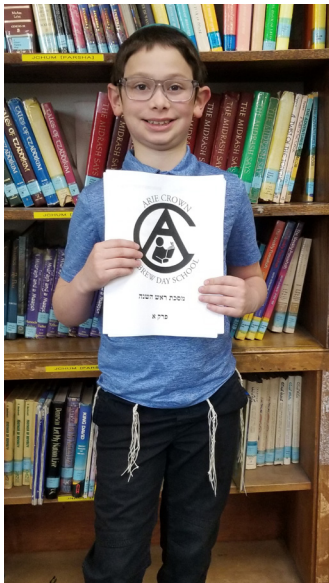
7th & 8th Grade Girls News

The 7th and 8th grade girls are hard at work, committed to helping our community and excited to be part of this amazing Mitzvah of Maos Chitim.



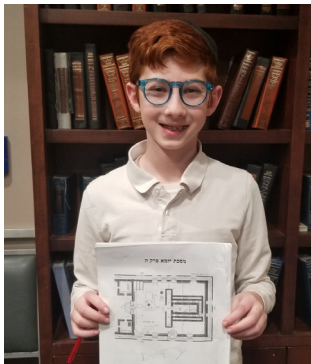


Boys Mishmar Spotlight by Rabbi Gottesman

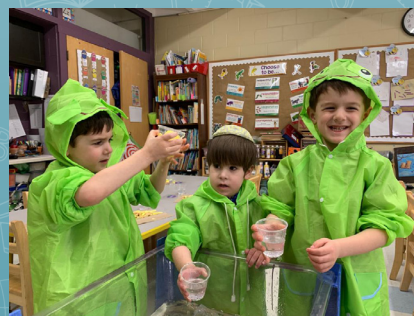
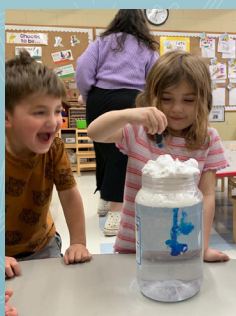
