In Morah Abowitz's Halacha class the girls learned Hilchot Pesach and worked on a project for the Chag! There is so much learning and excitement in our class B"H!














In Morah Abowitz's class we combined learning with art and brought our learning to life with paint!

The 2nd grade girls made beautiful pillows to use at the Pesach Seder. They also decorated posters depicting each of the 10 Makkos.


































Last week in Kindergarten, we began a unit on coins, learning to recognize the different denominations. One of the things the students noticed was how dirty our pennies were so we wanted to answer the question, "What would be the best thing we can use to clean a penny?" The students brainstormed and came up with ketchup, vinegar, baking soda, apple juice, hand sanitizer, and hand soap. They covered the pennies and left them for a few days before washing them off. The students made many predictions which all turned out to be wrong. Surprisingly, the ketchup did the best job!

In Kindergarten math, we are learning how to write math sentences and practiced using the symbols for minus and equals. Using a giant floor number line, the students practiced subtraction and wrote their math sentences on the board. Math is one of our favorite subjects! (Along with phonics and science!!)
