## ARIE CROWN KOLLEL MECHANCHIM ATERES AVRAHAM

Tuesday night marked the meaningful inauguration of Kollel Mechanchim Ateres Avraham at Arie Crown Hebrew Day School, a new initiative dedicated to strengthening the atmosphere of Limud Hatorah in the confines of the school.

The event was attended by Arie Crown's Rabbeim along with donors to the Kollel, who gathered to mark the beginning of this important endeavor.

Divrei chizuk were delivered by Rabbi Yehuda Nadoff, Rosh Chabura of the Kollel, who shared the goals and vision for the program. Rabbi Meyer Magence spoke about the personal and emotional significance of the Kollel being dedicated in memory of his father, R' Avraham Magence z"l by his children Abie and Ronit Gutnicki. Rabbi Yosef Rajchenbach of the Peterson Park Kollel offered insight into the lasting value of Torah learning and mitzvah observance as a chabura, and how such efforts can uplift a community.

Beyond the impact on the Rabbeim themselves, the Kollel sends a powerful message to the students of Arie Crown: that no matter what path one takes in life, staying connected to Torah is essential. Seeing their Rabbeim engaged in serious learning outside of classroom hours reinforces the idea that Torah is a lifelong pursuit — not just something taught, but something lived.

## PARENT/VISITOR *policy*

Visitors must enter school through the main entrance and sign-in to obtain a visitor lanyard in the front office. This includes all school volunteers.

- We appreciate all our volunteers and parent visitors but respectfully ask that you go only to the place(s) you are scheduled to go while you are in the building.
- All visitors must leave a photo ID at the front office and will receive a visitor lanyard which must be worn at all times.
- Visitors should never ask a student or teacher to allow them entry into the building.

## BUS/CARPOOL *notice*

### IMPORTANT SAFETY ITEMS TO NOTE:

- For the safety of our students, families and staff, the speed limit in the Arie Crown parking lot is 5 miles per hour.
- Please adhere to the ACHDS staff, volunteers and Skokie Police directions when you arrive in order to ensure the safety of the students.
- Carpool drivers **MUST** remain in their cars. Drivers getting out of their cars in the active carpool lane causes safety concerns and impedes running a smooth carpool line.
- Please stay alert so you can move forward promptly when the space in front of you opens up.
- For everyone's safety, stay off your phones. It is illegal and extremely dangerous.
- Never attempt to leave the carpool line to cut across the parking lot as that poses a serious danger for our students and staff.
- Do not park in a space in the lot and ask your children to cross the carpool line by themselves in order to reach your car.

### MINYAN ARRIVAL

Minyan arrival for boys in Grades 6-8 is from 7:15am - 7:30 am.

Please enter through the South Gate on Frontage Road and proceed to the gym entrance dropoff point. After safely dropping off your children, please follow the carpool line to exit through the North Gate on Frontage Road.

### MORNING ARRIVAL

Morning arrival is from 8:15am - 8:30am. Classes begin promptly at 8:30 am.  
There is no early morning drop off. Please only drop off at the location assigned to you.

Each family will be assigned to one of the following arrival locations:

Early Childhood Area pickup/dropoff point  
1-8 Grade (Gym area) pickup/dropoff point

Please note that your morning arrival and afternoon dismissal points may differ depending on whether you have an Early Childhood student in your carpool.

### AFTERNOON CARPOOL STUDENTS

Please share this information with anyone who is driving (i.e. grandparents etc.)

Each Afternoon carpool family should have received two copies of a colored, laminated carpool number at Back to School Days. If you did not, please stop by the business office to pick them up before school begins. You must display your school issued number near the passenger side of your front windshield when doing afternoon carpool.

### BUSING STUDENTS

Please note that there were a few minor changes to bus stops since Back to School Days. Please click on the files below to double check your child's stop number and location.

#### Morning Busing

The morning minyan bus route begins at 6:40am. Please click on the file below to see your children's bus number and location of their bus stop. For the first week, we recommend that your children wait outside a few minutes early. As the week progresses, you will be able to determine the approximate daily pick up time for their stop.

#### Afternoon Busing

At 3:55pm, ALL students who will be taking the bus will be dismissed to the bus loading area. Buses are scheduled to depart from school at 4:05pm daily and at 1:20pm on short Fridays.

Numerous hours of work were spent organizing the most efficient routes. Please be patient and allow the next several weeks for the bus drivers to learn the nuances of these routes. No changes will be made in the routes for at least the next 4 weeks.

As a reminder, for the safety of all students, it is the expectation of the school that any students in grades K-3 who are not being walked home by a sibling or neighbor should be met at their afternoon bus stop by an adult.

**LOST & FOUND** *news*

Please remember to label all items that go to school.

Some tips:

- All types of shoes end up in the Lost and Found each year - either due to changing out of boots, or into gym shoes. Consider labeling shoes as well.
- There are thin rectangle labels that are perfect for labeling eyeglasses. Labeling eyeglasses enables us to return them to their rightful owner when they show up in the Lost and Found.
- When school sweatshirts are distributed, remember to label immediately, as these are one of the most commonly found items in the Lost and Found. There are very handy name stampers available that are great for labeling clothing.
