

ידיעות התורה

"Ki sivne bayis chadash v'asisa ma'akeh l'gagecha" (Devarim 22:8)

The Torah teaches us a vital lesson about safety in our homes. This Mitzvah instructs us to install protective railings on rooftops to prevent accidents and keep everyone safe. Looking more closely at the Pasuk, we might wonder why the person who falls is called a "faller," as if their fall is certain. Rashi explains that it has been decreed that a certain person will suffer a tragic fall, but the exact location is not fixed. If we neglect this Mitzvah, the person destined to fall may meet their unfortunate fate on that rooftop. This teaches us how carefully Hashem judges each person's actions, highlighting both our individual responsibility and how our choices affect others.

Years ago, nine Yeshiva Bachurim were traveling to a wedding in New York when their flight made an emergency landing nearby. They decided to daven Maariv at the airport, and a janitor introduced himself as a Jew and joined them, forming a minyan. The janitor shared that he hadn't prayed or entered a Shul in decades but was moved by a dream he had the previous night from his late father, who asked him to say Kaddish on his Yahrzeit—if a Minyan appeared. That unexpected minyan was these Yeshiva Bochurim, exactly where they were meant to be. This story reminds us that Hashem is always in control and watching over us.

Have a wonderful Shabbos and may Hashem inscribe all of Am Yisroel a כתיבה וחתימה טובה.
